**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7-1-15 OF THE
VILLAGE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF KIRKLAND, ILLINOIS
RELATING TO SHUT OFF AND RECONNECTION OF VILLAGE WATERWORKS**

WHEREAS, the Village of Kirkland is authorized to enact ordinances and resolutions to regulate Village waterworks pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board deems it advisable and best interest to amend Section 7-1-15 (D) of the Village Code relating to the shut off and reconnection of Village waterworks,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF KIRKLAND, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1. The foregoing preambles are incorporated in this Section as if fully stated herein.

SECTION 2. Section 7-1-15 (D) is hereby amended as follows:

Water May be Shut Off for Violation of Chapter: For any violation of the provisions of this Chapter, or refusal or neglect to observe the provisions of this Chapter, including but not limited to the provisions of this Chapter relating to the payment of Water Meter Deposits and water and sewer charges, the Superintendent shall have power and he is hereby given authority to shut off the supply of water, and the same shall not be turned on again until a reconnection fee of one-hundred dollars (\$100.00) be paid to the Village in addition to any and all delinquent deposits or fines due. Unless otherwise provided by law, water shall be reconnected only during normal business hours established by the Department of Public Works. The provisions of this section shall be in addition to other penalties provided in this Chapter. It shall be unlawful for any person or corporation to turn or cause to be turned on any water or sewer connection without first having obtained a permit to do so from the Superintendent of Public Works.

SECTION 3. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4: All Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
